

STUDENT DISPLAYS AN UNEXPECTED BEHAVIOR



Redirect:

Non-Verbal Cues; Proximity, Eye Contact, Redirection Gesture **Redirect Whole Class**; Recognizing students who are following expected behaviors

If the Behavior Improves: **Positively** Reinforce

If the Behavior Does Not Change

Precision Statement: Privately with Student

- * "I notice you are (name the unexpected behavior)."
- "I need you to (state the expected behavior)."
- "I know you will make a good choice to do what's expected."

Walk Away

If the Behavior Improves; **Positively** Reinforce

If the Behavior **Does Not Change**



THINK TIME:

Provide a Pass on Student's Desk

- The student moves to the designated Think Time area; a space away from others for the student take a breather.
- \star Allow a few minutes for the student to transition and calm themselves.
- Provide the Think Time form when the \star student is calm and ready.
- Debrief with the student and help them \star re-engage.

If the Behavior does Not Change, Call the Office for CUB Patrol

CUB Patrol

CUB Patrol Support Team Staff Led Discussion

- Teacher calls main office \star
- CUB Patrol Personnel will arrive within 5 minutes (Student will complete Think Time Sheet with CUB Patrol OR with his/her teacher)

If the Student is **Ready**, Re-enter the Classroom

If the Student is Not Ready to **Return to Class**

Admin Will Contact

Home

The student will be brought to the office with the CUB Patrol Team. Admin will contact home. If reoccurring, a conference with the family will be required.

Procedures:

- Classroom teacher contacts Lia (5911) and says,
 "This is ______ in Room ______. I
 need Cub Patrol for _____."
 (If the office staff does not answer, the teacher will make note of the time to indicate gaps in the schedule.)
 Lia radios Cub Patrol and says, "______ in
- Room _____ needs Cub Patrol for _____."
- 3) Cub Patrol repeats the information and says, "Thank you! I'm on my way."
- 4) Cub Patrol will arrive within 5 minutes.
